From the Priest

Summer is almost here, and it promises to be a season of renewal and joy at St. John's, Shaughnessy. While we tend to think of things slowing down for summer, as we enjoy the outdoors and much-needed holidays, we have lots of good things in store at our parish. I thought this week I would share a few updates with you.

First, we will continue our new tradition of taking "hymn requests" throughout the summer. When I was a child, my aunt was a DJ at a local radio station. I used to love going to work with her, pushing flashing buttons, loading tracks into machines, and playing with the recording equipment. My favourite part, though, was the "All Request Lunch" that happened at noon. I enjoyed getting to "help" my aunt answer phones and then look up the songs people had requested. And I loved hearing the reasons people sometimes gave for their choices—a song that reminds them of riding in a car with their teenage friends; a song that was played at a special event; a song that reminds them of a loved one. It was great fun!

This summer, I am excited to experience that same joy as we share our favourite hymns and the stories behind them. What would you like to sing at worship? It could be a hymn from Common Praise, or from another hymnal or musical tradition. What are the spiritual songs that draw you into worship and warm your heart and your spirit? Please share them with me in an email or write them down and place them in the offering plate. Be sure to share your name and why you've chosen those specific hymns, so that we can acknowledge their meaning when we sing them.

This summer we'll also enjoy the return of our services of Evensong. The first one is scheduled for this Sunday at 4pm. If you've never been to an evensong service, it is a lovely way to end the day with Scripture, prayer, and beautiful music. I hope you'll join us for worship, followed by festive libations. And go ahead and mark your calendars for the next one on Sunday, August 14, on the eve of the feast of St. Mary the Virgin.

Finally, our music focus group has concluded its work with our consultant from Victoria, and we are looking forward to posting a position description for our new choir director very soon. We are also developing a charter for a music committee, which will oversee our efforts to develop an intentional concert season and to raise the profile of St. John's in the wider musical community. The Common Cup is Back!

Whether you are a "sipper" or a "skipper" (no "dipping" allowed, per diocesan regulations!), the common cup has returned and is available to you. If you prefer not to drink from the chalice, that's absolutely fine, and you're still encouraged to remain at the altar rail until it is offered to you, so that you might hear the words, "The Blood of Christ, shed for you." At that time, you can simply touch the base of the chalice or look upon it reverently. This is a perfectly valid way to engage with the consecrated wine, if for any reason drinking from the chalice is not the right choice for you. In fact, many people in recovery have been doing so for years-- long before the recent pandemic!

Now that the chalice has returned, we are in need of more lay administrants to offer it to the congregation. This is an extremely important ministry, and we would love for you to join us. It is not a difficult task and training will be offered. Many people describe administering the chalice as one of the most moving spiritual experiences they've had in church. 
Winter clothing, raingear, boots, sleeping bags, socks, pudding cups, granola bars (soft with no fruit/nuts), & juice boxes.
